Significant Flood Warning

According to Latest Hydro-Meteorological conditions, River Chenab at

MARALA is likely to attain **HIGH FLOOD** Level ranging between 2,00,000 to 3,00,000 Cusecs from 1400 PST of 12th July 2021 to 100 PST of 13th July 2021.

River Chenab at **KHANKI** is likely to attain **HIGH FLOOD** Level ranging between 2,00,000 to 3,00,000 Cusecs from 0000 PST to 1800 PST of 13th July 2021.

River Chenab at **QADIRABAD** is also likely to attain **HIGH FLOOD** Level ranging between 2,00,000 to 3,00,000 Cusecs from 0600 PST to 2400 PST of 13th July 2021.

Nullahs of River Chenab are also likely to attain **HIGH FLOOD** Level flows from 1800 PST of 12th July 2021 to 2400 PST of 13th July 2021.

All the concerned authorities are advised to remain **ALERT** during the period and take precautionary measures accordingly.
