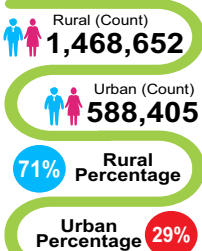
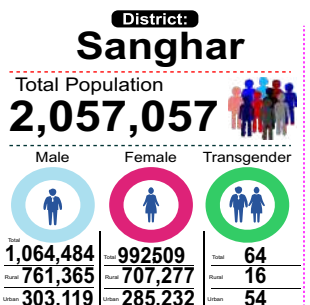
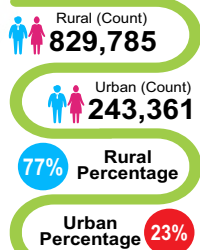
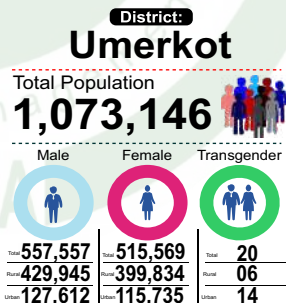
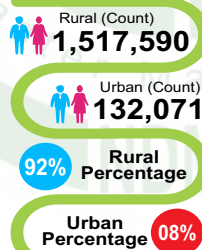
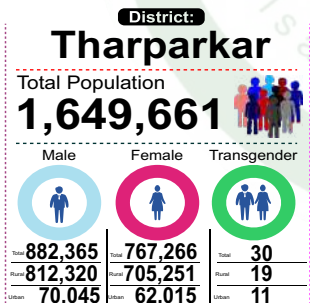
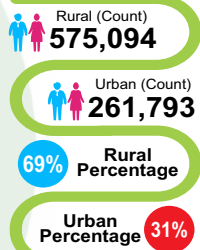
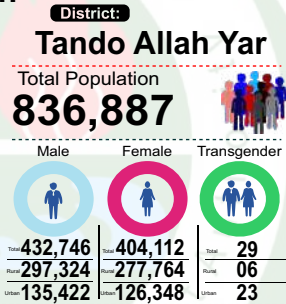
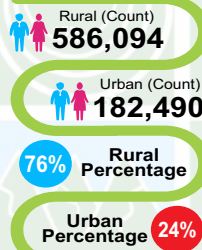
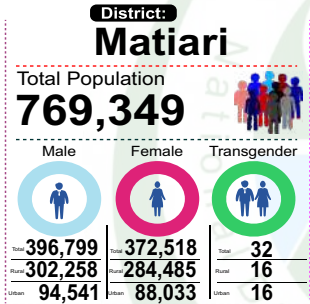


ANTICIPATED EXPOSURE

Sindh



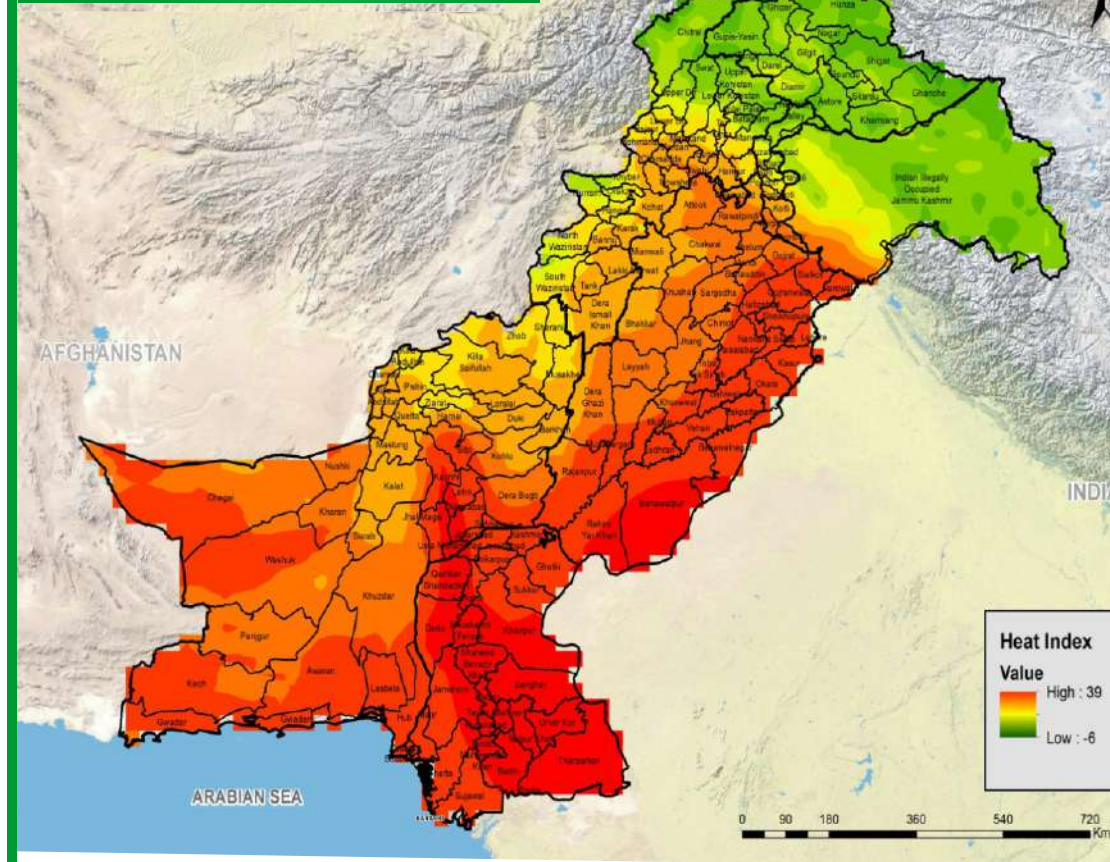

FORECAST

- A severe heatwave is expected in the mentioned districts from **15th May, 2024** to **31st May 2024** with temperatures likely to soar above 45°C (113°F).

EXPOSED DISTRICTS

- Umarkot, Tharparkar, Tando Allahyar, Matiari and Sanghar in Sindh and Bahawalpur and Rahim Yar Khan in Punjab.

ESSENTIAL HEATWAVE PRECAUTIONS

- Try to avoid outdoor activities during the hottest part of the day (11am-3pm).
