- 7. Weather Forecast for Next 24 Hours by PMD. Isolated thunderstorm/rain is expected over the upper catchments of all Major Rivers along with Kohat, Bannu, DI Khan, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Sargodha, Lahore, Multan and DG Khan Divisons. Scattered thunderstorm / rain of moderate intensity with isolated heavy falls is expected over Sindh & Balochistan.

- 9. <u>Weather Advisory / Press Release</u>. In response to PMD weather alert NDMA has issued weather advisory to all concerned on 12th July 2021 that strong monsoon weather system giving rains in the country is likely to persist during the week. Under the influence of this weather system, following is predicted:

- Manshera, Abbottabad, Haripur, Mardan, Swabi, Charsadda, Nowhsera, Peshawar, Wazirstan, Kurrum, Bannu, Kohat, Lakki Marwat, Tank, Karak and Dera Ismail Khan, Gilgit Baltistan (Ghizer, Astore, Diamer, Skardu, Gilgit, Hunza, Nagar, Ghanche, and Kharmang) from Monday to Thursday (12th 15th July 2021.
- b.
