SUBJECT: -RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:**I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION:**

River Kabul at Nowshera and River Indus at Chashma are in Low Flood Level.

II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:

- a. Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over Northeastern parts of Afghanistan today lies over northern parts of the country.
- b. Yesterday's low-pressure area over Northeast Madhya Pradesh & adjoining areas remained stationary.
- c. Mild moist currents from Bay of Bengal are penetrating to upper parts of the country up to 5000 feet.
- d. Seasonal low lies over Northwest Balochistan.

III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Scattered wind thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity with one or two places heavy fall is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Islamabad and Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu, DI Khan, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Sargodha, DG Khan, Zhob, Sibbi, Nasirabad & Kalat Divisions. Isolated wind thunderstorm /rain is expected over Lahore, Faisalabad, Sahiwal, Multan & Bahawalpur Divisions along with Southeast Sindh.

IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NEXT 48-HOURS:

No significant change is expected.
