#### SUBJECT: -RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

#### I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION:

1 President Secretariat Islamabad

PM House, Islamabad.

River Kabul at Nowshera & River Chenab at Khanki are in Low Flood Level. Low level Flash Flooding is expected in the Hill Torrents of DG Khan Division.

#### **METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:**

- Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over Kashmir & adjoining areas has moved away Eastwards & yesterday's another trough of westerly wave over Northeastern parts of Iran today lies over Northern parts of Afghanistan.
- Mild moist currents from Bay of Bengal are penetrating to upper parts of the country, while from Arabian sea to South Punjab up to 5000 feet.
- Yesterday's low-pressure area over North Odisha moved West- Northwestwards and today lies over North Chhattisgarh & adjoining areas.
- Seasonal low lies over North Balochistan.

#### III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Scattered wind thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity with isolated heavy fall is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Islamabad and Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu, DI Khan, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Lahore, Sargodha, DG Khan, Zhob, Sibbi, Nasirabad & Kalat Divisions. Isolated wind thunderstorm /rain is expected over Faisalabad, Sahiwal, Multan & Bahawalpur Divisions.
