OVERVIEW OF DISTRICT TANDO MUHAMMAD KHAN

❖ **BRIEF HISTORY:**

The Place in the sub-continent where the Islam emerged first is Sindh. After the retreatment of Arab conquerors this region was ruled by the locals like Soomras, Samans, Kalhoras and Mirs. The dynasty of these local rulers remained in power till 1843 A.D. Afterward the Sindh was annexed by the British. Mirs establish their villages and sites in the jagirs and lands which were bestowed to them by their rulers. They gave the title "TANDO" to these villages and sites, the meaning of which is the village or site established by the particular person. In 1791 A.D it was named as Tando Muhammad Khan derived its name from Mir Muhammad Khan Talpur. Tando Muhammad Khan remained as a very reminiscent town of Sehwan Talpurs. Earlier it was a village of Taluka "GUNI" and later on declared as a Taluka and sub-division of Hyderabad. Tando Muhammad Khan remained as a Taluka of Hyderabad District till April 2005, when it was declared as district and first district government established in October 2005.

❖ **GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION:**

Tando Muhammad Khan is one of the districts located in the south of the province of Sindh. In north Hyderabad and Tando Allahyar Districts are located, Badin District lies on south and east. West boundary is shared by district Thatta and the river Indus flows through North-West. This district is situated at the distance of 35 Km from Hyderabad, 70 Km from Badin, 105 Km from Thatta, and about 75 Km from Tando Allahyar. It is located between 22-11 and 22-09 North Latitude and 60-19, 62-15 East Longitude. Area of district Tando Muhammad Khan is 4, 29,936 Acres (1, 733 Sq KMS). While its population as per 1998 census ranges to 447215 souls.

❖ **CLIMATE:**

When compared to rest of the climatically harsher areas of Sindh province, this district is classified to be moderate in its climate. However May, June & July are very hot during the day time, whereas December, January & February are the coldest months. During the months of May and June the temperature ranges between 33°C to 45°C. Summer heat is considerably relieved by blowing of south western breeze from the sea. During the winter the temperature ranges between 11°C to 25°C. Some time however the north winds originating from Queta (Baluchistan) contribute to the extremely cold spells.

This district falls within the rain shadow area. The summers are usually dry with some bouts of monsoon rains in the months of July, August and September. Rainfall is highly erratic with an average of about 130 mm. The monsoon dominates from July to September.



❖ CULTURE & CIVILIZATION:

District Tando Muhammad Khan is famous for preparation of traditional symbol of Sindh known as "AJRAK", "Farasi" & "Kaashi". It also contributes a big portion in sugar production in Sindh province. A famous festival "Melo of Hazarat Shah Abdul Karim Bulri Waro" is being celebrated annually in city of Bulri Shah Karim.

However, the graveyard of Jats located at some 20 kilometres south of Tando Muhammad Khan near the famous Buddhist stupa is quite prominent. It is also known as Makhdum Jo Qabristan (cemetery of Makhdoom). It can easily be approached from Saidpur village. The necropolis is hovering atop the hill overlooking the railway line that connects Tando Muhammad Khan with Hyderabad. The cemetery contains gravestones of Jats.

❖ LANGUAGES:

Sindhi is the major language of the District, although Urdu, saraiki, Balochi, Punjabi, Marvari, Gujrati and Pashto are also spoken and understood, Persian is the language spoken by the Hazara (Mughal) tribe of Late General Moosa Khan Living in Bulri Shah Karim and Sarhandis living in Village Tando Saindad situated at 1 Km distance at Tando Muhammad Khan city.

❖ MAIN TRIBES:

Various communities like Samoon, Syed, Talpur, Soomras, Memon, Leghari, Lashari, Khaskheli, Rajput, Magsi, Rind, Chandio, Jat, Lakho, Jalalani, Bhatti, Shoro, Dars, Dal, Bagrani, Maheri, Kaheri, Mallah, Khoso, Katiar, Turk, Jagsi, Lund, Halepoto, Jamari, Chang, Berhamani, Khuwaja, Nizamani, Shaikh, Keerio, Almani, Jamali, Sathio, Noonari, Maganhar, Siyal, Mallah, Burdi, Brohi, Solongi, Paliyo, Jokhio, Sand, Kathor, Khodio, Hindu, Christian, etc are living in Tando Muhammad Khan District.

❖ OCCUPATION:

The main occupations of the people of District are Agriculture, trade, labour/skilled labour. Prominent educationists, Agriculturists, professionals like engineers, doctors, technical experts, specially in the field of sugar industry, oil exploration, lawyers, planners, housing experts are playing their prime role in the development/economical activities of the district. The occupational involvement in industry is also overwhelming. A considerable segment of society adopts government /private service as their occupation.

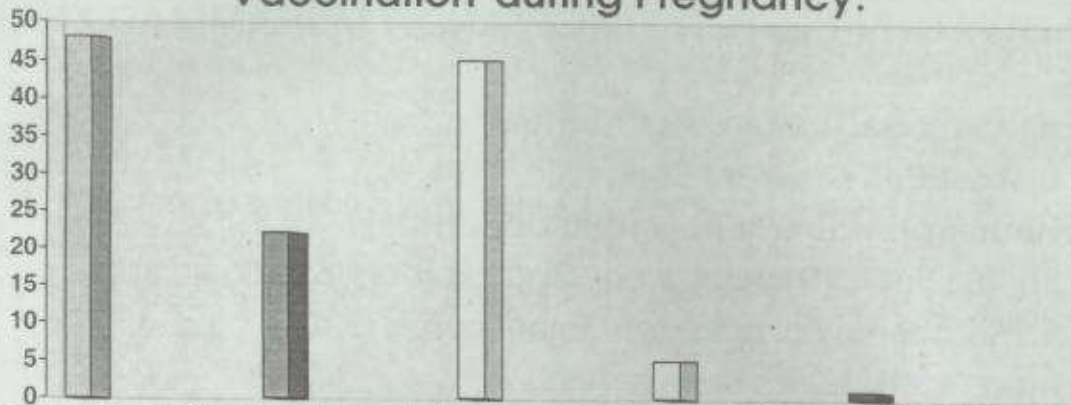

Prevention of neonatal tetanus is a part of immunization program. Pregnant women receive at least two tetanus toxoid vaccinations during their pregnancy. In Tando Muhammad Khan 48% women had not received any TT vaccination during pregnancy. 45% received required 2 doses while 5% received 3 doses 4 or more doses were given to 1% women's. It can be assumed that 48% women and their newborns were not protected from tetanus during the last delivery.

Major Development Schemes Carried Out in Tando Muhammad Khan District

- A. With the hectic efforts of Honorable Syed Naveed Qamar Federal Minister for Petroleum and Natural Resources, Sui gas facility have been provided to more than 100 Villages of District.

Finance & Planning Department Introduction

The finance and Planning Group of offices, being the custodian of District Government Funds has to execute sound financial management and maintains strict financial discipline through various financial controls. Beside a sound revenue base a good financial management is a prerequisite for ensuring the performance of the obligatory functions and bringing improvement in quality of life, for the social advantages are measured only through tight financial control. Consequent upon the devolution of various departments from Provincial Government to District Government Tando Muhammad Khan, the span of financial management has increased manifold.

An efficient financial control ensures continuous appreciation of relation between expenditure on one hand and financial resources and provisions on the other. Proper accounting system and the regular audit i.e. internal audit, pre-audit and post-audit strengthens the financial disciplines. Appropriate adherence of audit observations, which are intended to eliminate the chances of leakages of revenues and intending action against the defaulting staff, is yet another factor for maintaining financial disciplines.

The Finance and Planning Group of Offices is obliged to have its own sophisticated Computer Technology to maintain the computer based Financial Management System through which the reconciliation of income from various resources on daily basis, maintenance of accounts and tight budgetary controls under the respective budgets heads, have been applied.

Due care is always taken to accentuate that the development plans of District Government are not hampered for deficiency of funds. Strenuous efforts are made



to reduce the gap between the expenditure and income through constant project Monitoring.

Future Plans:

4. Tourism Point/Parks and motel will be established in Tando Muhammad Khan City and in this connection Chair-lift will be started over the Phulleli, New Guni, Pandhi Wah & Akram Wah.
5. The District Headquarter Hospital will be completed shortly.
6. All the Villages of District Tando Muhammad Khan will be facilitated with Health School and Sui Gas facility on war footing basis.
7. District Government Officer Residence colony, (G.O.R) will be constructed and in this connection land for Revenue Colony has already been proposed.

ACHIEVEMENTS OF WORK & SERVICES DEPARTMENT



FUNCTION AND DUTIES

The EDO shall:

- a) Assist the DCO in formulation of policy and bring to his notice the cases which are required to be submitted to the Zila Nazim under the rules.
- b) Duly execute the sanctioned policy.
- c) Being the official head of the group of district offices is responsible for its efficient administration and discipline and for the proper conduct of business assigned to the group of offices.
- d) Submit all proposals for taxation and bye-laws to the Zila Council through DCO and Zila Nazim.
- e) Be responsible to DCO for the proper conduct of the business of the group of district offices and keep him informed about the working of the district offices.
- f) Where the Zila Nazim orders appear to involve a departure from rules, regulations or Government policy, resubmit the case to the Zila Nazim inviting his attention to the relevant rules, regulations or Government policy and if the Zila Nazim still disagrees with the EDO, the EDO through DCO shall refer the case to the Provincial Local Government Commission for decision.
- g) Subject to any general or special order of Government in this behalf, issue standing orders specifying the cases or other classes of cases which may be disposed of by an officer subordinate to the EDO.
- h) Be responsible for the careful observance of the rules in his group of district offices.
- i) While submitting a case for the orders of the Zila Nazim or DCO it shall be the duty of the EDO to suggest a definite line of action.
- j) The EDO is authorized for posting and transfers of officials BPS-1 to 10 in the district.
- k) He will act as departmental Accounting Officer for Works and Services group of offices and be responsible to the District Accounts Committee of Zila Council.
- l) The EDO may correspond directly with the heads of other groups of the district Government or with Provincial Government, any of the local authority (civil or military) regarding matters relating to his group of offices.
- m) He will exercise all technical powers as exercised by the Superintending Engineer in Communication and Works Department.

FUNCTIONING OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT



Introduction

The Community Development Department is working in District Government system as per SLGO 2001 under control of Executive District Officer for transformation of Community to betterment in living style & creation of infra-structure in both the rural & urban areas through motivation & contribution of the communities.

The following group of offices is functioning under the administrative control of the Executive District Officer, CDD, Tando Muhammad Khan.

1. **Office of the District Officer, Labour.**
2. **Office of the District Officer, Social Welfare**
3. **Office of the District Officer Sports & Culture**
4. **Office of the District Officer Cooperative and Registration.**

(I) FUNCTIONS OF LABOUR WING:

- a) Maintenance of Industrial places.
- b) Welfare of labour including:
 - (i) Promotion of settlement in case of industrial dispute.
 - (ii) Audit and scrutiny of accounts of Trade Unions in the Districts.
 - (iii) Implementation of compensation of claims and non-payment of wages.
- c) Implementation and enforcement of labour laws both central and provincial including:
 - (i) Implementation of government policies for the gradual elimination of child labour.
 - (ii) Coordination of government efforts for abolition of bonded labour.
 - (iii) Registration / de-registration of factories, shops and establishments.
 - (iv) Inspection of factories /transport under labour laws.
 - (v) Inspection of shops under shops and establishment ordinance.
 - (vi) Manpower and employment.
 - (vii) Enforcement of weights and measures law.
 - (viii) Purchase of stores and capital goods at district level.

(II) FUNCTION OF SOCIAL WELFARE WING:

The Social Welfare wing functions under administrative control of Social Welfare Department, Government of Sindh and at district level under control of Community Development Department, District Government. The offices of the Deputy District Officers are under control of District Officer, Social Welfare.

- (i) Creation of social awareness by motivational methods.
 - (ii) Professional and financial assistance to registered voluntary social welfare agencies.
 - (iii) Socio-economic development of the people, particularly women.
 - (iv) Training and rehabilitation of the destitute under privileged, handicapped and chronically sick.
 - (v) Eradication of social evils.
 - (vi) Assist relief and rescue services during calamities and National Emergency.
 - (vii) Exercise admin and financial powers delegated under rules.
 - (viii) Exercise powers/control over voluntary social welfare agencies.
 - (ix) Guide voluntary social welfare agencies towards their capacity building.
 - (x) Coordinate with all line departments/district administration.
 - (xi) Consolidate/update the physical and financial performance reports.
 - (xii) Organize campaigns and program against social evils through NGOs.
 - (xiii) Organize relief work through NGOs/Philanthropists.
 - (xiv) Registration Authority powers.
 - (xv) Recommend cases of licenses Licensing Authority (DGSW) in respect of the children's Home (Orphanages).
- 47 NGOs have been registered up-to-date (list enclosed).

(III) FUNCTION OF SPORTS WINGS:

To promote the sports activities in Rural and Urban areas and register with District sports Association according to sports policy of District. At present the post of District Officer, Sports is vacant.

(IV) FUNCTION OF COOPERATIVES AND REGISTRATION WING:

- a) Cooperative Societies having area of operation restricted to a district.
- b) National Scheme for Cooperative Farming.



- c) Training to the filed officials of the Cooperative Department and office bearers of cooperative societies in book keeping, maintenance of accounts, minutes book preparation of loan documents etc.
- d) Appeals against order of the subordinate officer with regard to the matters relating to the cooperative Societies with area of operation restrained to Taluka/Village and capital of not more than Rs.50001/- or as may be prescribed by Provincial Government form time to time.
- e) Development schemes pertaining to Cooperatives as per delegation of powers.
- f) Service matters pertaining to officers/officials as per delegation of powers.
- g) Purchase of stores and capital goods for the district office.
